Aurora, Nebraska July 11, 2017

A meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Aurora, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 7:30 p.m. on July 11, 2017 at the City Hall. Present were Councilors: Paul Lackore, Wayne Roblee, Daniel Bartling, Dorothy Anderson, Dick Phillips and Nancy Lohrmeyer. Mayor David Long conducted the meeting. City Officials present were City Administrator Eric Melcher, City Attorney Ross Luzum, Chief of Police Paul Graham, Utilities Superintendent Adam Darbro and Clerk/Treasurer Barbra Mikkelsen.

Notice of said meeting was given by publication in the Aurora News Register on July 5, 2017. Notice of meeting was simultaneously given to the Mayor and all members of the Council and a copy of their acknowledgment of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these minutes. Availability of the agenda of this meeting was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and Council. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Long stated "AS PERSCRIBED BY LAW A COPY OF THE NEBRASKA OPEN MEETINGS ACT IS POSTED BY THE DOUBLE DOORS IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS."

MINUTES:

Councilor Lackore moved to approve the minutes from the June 27, 2017 meeting. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Roblee, Bartling, Anderson, Phillips, Lohrmeyer and Lackore. Nay: None. The motion carried.

PETITIONS, COMPLAINTS, COMMUNICATIONS:

REPORTS BY OFFICERS, BOARD, COMMITTEES:

Clerk/Treasurer Mikkelsen presented the Expenditures and Clerk/Treasurer reports for the month ending June 30, 2017. Councilor Phillips moved to approve said reports. Councilor Lohrmeyer seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Bartling, Anderson, Phillips, Lohrmeyer, Lackore and Roblee. Nay: None. The motion carried.

Claims Committee Member Lackore reported the claims presented by the Clerk were in order and moved that said claims be allowed and checks drawn on the various funds for payment of same be approved. Councilor Lohrmeyer seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Anderson, Phillips, Lohrmeyer, Lackore, Roblee and Bartling. Nay: None. The motion carried. A listing of said claims is attached to these minutes.

Ross Beins with the Aurora Airport Authority presented their levy request for fiscal year 2017-2016. The request is the same as last year. Councilor Lackore moved to approve the levy request from the Aurora Airport Authority for \$0.035 per \$100 of taxable valuation plus 1% as allowed by law. Councilor Roblee seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Phillips, Grossnicklaus, Lackore, Bartling and Anderson. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Roblee. The motion carried.

Mayor Long skipped to agenda item #13.

Kurt Mitchell from the Aurora Tennis Facility Design Build Committee and Aurora Recreation Committee updated the council on the Tennis Facility Project. Councilor Lackore moved to approve an amendment to the original Design Build Tennis Facilities Agreement including plans, specifications and funding for the 4 Court Tennis Facilities and to allow for the commencement of the project. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Lohrmeyer, Lackore, Roblee, Bartling, Anderson and Phillips. Nay: None. The motion carried.

Mayor Long went back to agenda item #5.

City Attorney Luzum read Ordinance No. 1045: AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND AND INCREASE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AURORA, COUNTY OF HAMILTON, STATE OF NEBRASKA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 17-405, R.R.S. 1943, BY ANNEXING THERETO A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND CONTIGUOUS TO AND NOT EMBRACED WITHIN THE PRESENT LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AURORA, CONSISTING OF STREETER PARK SECOND SUBDIVISION, AN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF AURORA, HAMILTON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, A PART OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER (SE1/4), OF SECTION THIRTY THREE (33), TOWNSHIP ELEVEN (11) NORTH, RANGE SIX (6) WEST OF THE 6TH P.M., HAMILTON COUNTY, NEBRASKA; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS, TO ORDER THE ORDINANCE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM, AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Councilor Roblee moved to bring Ordinance No. 1045 before the council and to approve the third reading of this ordinance. Councilor Phillips seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Lackore, Roblee, Bartling, Anderson, Phillips and Lohrmeyer. Nay: None. The motion carried.

Councilor Lackore moved for final adoption of Ordinance No. 1045. Councilor Lohrmeyer seconded the motion. The Mayor then stated the question, "Shall Ordinance No. 1045 be passed and adopted?" Upon roll call vote, the following Councilors voted Aye: Roblee, Bartling, Anderson, Phillips, Lohrmeyer and Lackore. Nay: None.

The passage and adoption of said Ordinance having been concurred in by a majority of all members elected to the Council was by the Mayor declared passed and adopted and the Mayor in the presence of the Council signed and approved said Ordinance and the Clerk attested the passage and approval of same and affixed her signature thereto. Said Ordinance shall be preserved and kept in a separate and distinct volume known as the Ordinance Record of the City of Aurora, Nebraska and same be incorporated herein by reference.

7:35P.M. PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor Long opened the duly advertised public hearing to receive public comments regarding the annexation of properties adjacent and contiguous to the corporate limits of the City of Aurora, parts of sections 32 and 33, Hamilton County, Nebraska. Zoning Administrator Darbro reviewed the property to be annexed. Mayor Long asked if there was anyone present who wished to speak in favor of the recommendation and there was no one. The Mayor then asked if there was anyone present who wished to speak in opposition to the proposed recommendation and there was no one. There being no one present to speak in favor of or opposition to the proposed recommendation the Mayor declared the public hearing closed.

City Attorney Luzum read Ordinance No. 1047: AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND AND INCREASE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AURORA, COUNTY OF HAMILTON, STATE OF NEBRASKA, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 17-405.01, R.R.S.1943, BY ANNEXING THERETO A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND CONTIGUOUS OR ADJACENT TO AND NOT EMBRACED WITHIN THE PRESENT LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AURORA, CONSISTING OF A PART OF WILTFONG SUBDIVISION, HAMILTON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, TO REPEAL PRIOR ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS, TO ORDER THE ORDINANCE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM, AND TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Councilor Lackore moved to approve Pay Application No. 3 for the WWTF Solar System Project in the amount of \$89,280. Councilor Roblee seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Phillips, Lohrmeyer, Lackore, Roblee, Bartling and Anderson. Nay: None. The motion carried.

Councilor Phillips moved to approve a plumber's license for David P Kirby of Extreme Plumbing Co., LLC from Grand Island, NE. Councilor Roblee seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Lohrmeyer, Lackore, Roblee, Bartling, Anderson and Phillips. Nay: None. The motion carried.
