Councilor Anderson moved to approve the request from Grand Island Crisis Center for funding for FY 2017-2018 for \$2,000. Councilor Phillips seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Phillips, Lohrmeyer, Roblee, Bartling and Anderson. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Lackore. The motion carried.

City Administrator Melcher discussed the budget.
