Mayor Seeman opened the duly advertised public hearing to receive public comments regarding the Preliminary Plat of Diamond 2nd Subdivision, a replat of Diamond Subdivision, City of Aurora, Hamilton County, Nebraska, a part of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼), Section Thirty-Three (33), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Six (6) West of the 6th P.M., Hamilton County, Nebraska. Mayor Seeman asked if anyone wished to speak at the public hearing in support or opposition. There being no one present to speak in favor of or opposition to the proposed recommendation the Mayor declared the public hearing closed.

Mayor Seeman opened the duly advertised public hearing to receive public comments regarding the Final Plat of Diamond 2nd Subdivision, a replat of Diamond Subdivision, City of Aurora, Hamilton County, Nebraska, a part of the Southeast Quarter (SE¼), Section Thirty-Three (33), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Six (6) West of the 6th P.M., Hamilton County, Nebraska. Mayor Seeman asked if anyone wished to speak at the public hearing in support or opposition. There being no one present to speak in favor of or opposition to the proposed recommendation the Mayor declared the public hearing closed.

John Zwingman of Advance Consulting Engineering Services Inc. reviewed the bids for Streeter 3 and 4 subidvisions infrastructure improvements and recommended accepting the low bids in the three divisions to: Division I earthwork to Doernemann Construction for \$184,572.70, Division II water and sanitary sewer infrastructure to Ruthjens Construction for \$454,695.55 and Division III paving and storm sewer improvements and addendum to Mid Nebraska Land Developers for \$815,453.53 and \$47,520.20. Councilor Roblee moved to award the bids for Streeter 3 and 4 subdivisions to the low bidders as recommended by John Zwingman of Advance Consulting Engineering Services Inc. and to authorize Advance Consulting Engineering Services Inc. to prepare contract documents. Councilor Phillips seconded the motion.

Councilor Phillips moved to approve the request from Deb Kalkwarf of Grandview Café for a special designated liquor license for a reception at the Leadership Center, November 9, 2021, 5:30pm to 10:00pm. Councilor Dunn seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Roblee, Bartling, Dunn, Phillips and Lohrmeyer. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Lackore. The motion carried.

Councilor Lohrmeyer moved to approve the request from the Nebraska Vocational Agricultural Foundation d/b/a The Leadership Center for a special designated liquor license for the Annual Harvest Gala Fundraiser at The Leadership Center-Mather Hall, 2211 Q Street, on November 20, 2021 from 5:30pm to 11:59pm. Councilor Dunn seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Roblee, Bartling, Dunn, Phillips and Lohrmeyer. Nay: None. Absent and not voting: Lackore. The motion carried.
