Charles McGraw of Community Action Partnership of Mid Nebraska-RYDE Transit reviewed the budget request for 2025-2026 for the public transportation service in Hamilton County. The request is for the \$17,920 which is an increase of \$2,834 from last year. Councilor Phillips moved to approve Resolution 25-01 instructing Community Action Partnership of Mid Nebraska-RYDE Transit to apply for federal funds and to provide for local funding match of \$17,920. Councilor Lackore seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Bartling, Dunn, Phillips, Bergen and Lackore. Nay: None. Absent and voting: Roblee. The motion carried and the following resolution was declared passed and adopted.

WHEREAS, the RYDE Transit-Community Action Partnership of Mid Nebraska desires to apply for said funds to provide public transportation in Hamilton County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Aurora hereby instructs the RYDE Transit to apply for said funds.

Said funds are to be used for the RYDE Transit transportation operations in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Application for Public Transportation Assistance.
