

NOTICE OF ELECTRICIAN REGISTRATION DUE JANUARY 1st

Section 10-403 to 10-404 inclusive Aurora City Code relative to Electricians requires that all persons wishing to do electrical work in Aurora must first obtain a State of Nebraska Electricians License and Register with the City of Aurora.

Before an Electrician can perform work in the City of Aurora they must submit the following:

- Copy of a valid and unexpired Class (A) Electrical Contractors License issued by the State of Nebraska.
or
- Copy of a valid and unexpired Electricians License issued by the State of Nebraska.
- Initial Registration fee in the amount of Fifty Dollar (\$50.00).
or
- Annual Renewal fee in the amount of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).
- Surety Bond in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000).

ORDINANCE 10-302 SURETY BOND: Each person, firm or corporation shall be required to provide the Municipality with a personal surety bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) signed by one or more sufficient sureties or a bond in a like amount from an approved corporate surety. The bond shall be conditioned that the licensee shall indemnify and hold harmless the City from all accidents, damage, liability, claims, judgments, costs, or expense caused by any negligence arising from a failure to adequately protect plumbing work, by unfinished, unskilled, or inadequate work or arising out of furnishing defective material.
